

# Fish Room

The Fish Room is for children that will be entering Kindergarten the next fall. The room is set up as the traditional preschool classroom. Children have a structured day that includes group time where they focus on pre-reading and pre-math skills. Children make choices and go to the centers that include art, science, dramatic play, books, large motor, puzzles & games, blocks & cars. There are planned activities that refine large & small motor skills, cognitive development, self-help skills, social skills and self-expression. This age group has formal evaluations in fall and spring where parents and the teacher sit down and discuss the child's Kindergarten readiness skills. Skills area that need attention are identified, and worked on, so they have a successful Kindergarten experience.
