We would like to welcome you to the Purple Room. The age group in the Purple Room is approximately 12 to 24 months.

The goal for the Purple Room is to provide a safe and nurturing environment for the children to explore and learn at their own pace. This is accomplished by understanding the ever demanding and changing needs of toddlers. Through daily communications with other staff and parents, planning monthly goals and activities and evaluations of each child's development we hope to successfully accomplish our goals. We will encourage your child to reach their maximum potential by helping them learn self-help skills while also promotion positive self-esteem.

A progress report is completed twice a year in October and May by the teacher(s) in the classroom and is given to each parent to review. Conference times are offered if a parent wishes to sit down with staff and discuss their child's development.

We ask that you bring the following supplies to be kept here in the classroom and as they become low or need replacements we will let you know:

- A blanket for naptime (no large comforters please)
- Diapers and wipes
- One or more change of clothes
- Seasonal clothing for outside

Storage for diapers and extra clothing is available in our bathroom shelf area. If you want to bring in a BIG bag of diapers, we can store them for your convenience.

Please feel free to visit the Purple Room at any time. Parents are always welcomed in hopes that you are able to observe your child during the busiest time of their day. If you have any questions or concerns always feel free to ask and we will do the best to answer them.
