Last Month's Preschool Skills

Last month the children learned a lot about the changes in weather from winter to spring. We also

learned about the earth on the fourth week and bugs and butterflies on the last week. We worked on using our gross motor skills through dancing and playing outside as weather allowed us. We created a lot of projects that practiced using their fine motor skills. We worked with each child on recognizing their name and how it's spelled and will continue to do that this month as well. The children will continue to work on proper table manners such as using their spoon and saying "more please", practicing using walking feet in the classroom, sharing, and saying please and thank you.

This Month's Preschool Skills

This month we will be learning about all the different changes that happen in springtime, from all the different flowers to the birds and changes in the trees. In the second week we will be learning about all the different kind of animals that live on the farm and in the fourth week we will be learning about all the fun things associated with camping. We will continue to work with each child on their names as well as practicing using our fine and gross motor skills. We will also be working with the children on the importance of being nice to one another and using manners.
