This month we will be working on our fine motor skills. Fine motor skills activities use movement to develop the small hand muscles in children. Some activities that we will be doing are putting pompoms in a water bottle (feed the turkey), playing in our sensory bin that will be filled with dried corn and using various things as scoopers and buckets, and putting dried corn in a water bottle to make a corn shaker. We still will be working on our normal everyday skills including using spoons properly, using inside voices, using walking feet while inside, and proper handwashing and drying.
