Sunscreen

Soon it will be that time of the year again when the children will be spending more time outside, weather permitting. We ask that you please bring in a bottle of sunscreen. Each teacher has a sunscreen permission form for you

to authorize them to apply sunscreen to your child. We will apply the sunscreen each morning before we head outside, and then again in the afternoon.

Water Bottles

We also ask that every child bring a labeled reusable water bottle with them daily that they can use for water outside. This water bottle will need to be taken home and washed nightly. Unfortunately, it has become a choking hazard to bring disposable water bottles (Ice Mountain, Aquafina) so we ask that these types of bottles not be brought to CLC.

Attendance

If there is a failure to notify CLC of an absence you will receive a phone call to verify the "whereabouts of your child".

Arrival and departure

Upon the arrival or departure of the center, it is very important that parents and caregiver visually and verbally check in with a staff member so they can record check in or check out on the daily attendance sheet. This is also a great time to pass any messages to the teacher, to check cubbies or mailboxes, or sign any necessary paperwork.

Parking Lot Safety
