In November, we will be gearing up talking about Winter. We will work on our self-help skills while putting on our coats and winter outerwear. Please remember that we go outside almost everyday and will need coats, hats, mittens, snow pants and boots once it snows. Please feel free to leave on your child's hook. As always, we will be continuing to work on our classroom skills, such as listening ears, walking feet, nice hands and inside voices.

Reminders:

1. Please check calendars daily.
2. Keep extra clothes on hooks and be sure they are seasonal and appropriate size.
3. Breakfast is at 8:30am, lunch is at 11:30am and snack is at 2:30pm. Please feed your child at home if they will not be here by 8:30am.
4. Dress accordingly for the weather. We do TRY to go outside each day and we need your children to be comfortable.
5. Make sure you write your child's name on everything they own.
